



			<p>1. for a "spirit of <b>prayer</b>" amongst Christians (Zechariah 12:10); a never ending passion for prayer and hunger to seek God's face (Ps 27:4): that we learn to pray with pleasure, power and faith (James 5:16-17); for a growing army of intercessors and an explosion of prayer teams.</p>	<p>2. for <b>love</b>, still the most important thing in God's kingdom (John 13:34-35, 1 Cor. 13): that the churches will be safe havens of love, peace, acceptance and grace (Rom. 13:8); for a growing depth in the <b>knowledge of God as a Father</b> (John 17:3),</p>	<p>3. for spiritual <b>freedom</b> and boldness amongst Christians: a victory mentality without shame or intimidation by the world (2 Timothy 1:7), willingness to leave comfort behind and bring sacrifices (Mat. 10:37-39), great generosity. For great faith and great vision.</p>	<p>4. (<i>Worldwide Day of Prayer for the Peace of Jerusalem</i>) for <b>Israel</b>, for the peace of Jerusalem (Ps 122:7), that many Jews will find their Messiah, but also for the Palestinians, for peace in the Middle East region (not the peace of men, but the peace of God); especially for Syria</p>
<p>5. for Christian <b>unity</b>: within churches, between churches, between denominations (John 17:20-21, Ephesians 4:1-6): breaking down the walls, prejudices and mistrust; for an active cooperation, for reconciliation between Christians, churches and leaders (Matt. 5:23-24)</p>	<p>6. for <b>holiness</b> amongst Christians (Hebrews 12:14): power to combat sin, discernment, the right priorities, laying down our lukewarm state, worldliness and materialism; endurance and discipline (Hebr. 12:1-2).</p>	<p>7. for <b>power and courage</b> for brothers and sisters who carry too heavy burdens: against discouragement, for new inspiration and energy (Is. 40:31); for Christians who are disappointed in churches and are church-less: for new hope and connection with the Body of Christ (Ef. 4:15-16).</p>	<p>8. for a spirit of <b>evangelization</b>: more compassion for a lost world (Mark 8:38), wisdom in evangelization methods that are creative and appealing to our culture (Col. 4:5-6).</p>	<p>9. for the formation of <b>new churches</b>: pray specifically for places in your area where there is yet no church; also for unreached people groups in our country; that those called will also obey and go out. (Mt 28:19)</p>	<p>10. for <b>missions</b>: for Belgian missionaries who have gone overseas (pray for those you know), for more missionaries, especially among unreached people groups (Mark 16:15); for good financial support for missions projects</p>	<p>11. for strong Christian <b>marriages and families</b> to shine as a light in the night: a warm unity, purity and love between husbands and wives; for real fathers and mothers; for wisdom and strength in the raising of children. (Hebr 13:4).</p>

12. for <b>church leaders</b> : vision, power, purity, wisdom, humility, authority from God (1 Pet. 5:2-3, Eph 6:19-20); for spiritual fatherhood, for protection in their families and health, for powerful preaching of <b>the Word</b> .	13. For <b>vocations</b> (Matthew 9:37-38): that God may send the labourers, a new generation of young leaders, for bible schools and other training facilities; for the release of <b>finances</b> for labourers (Matt. 10:10).	14. For the <b>five ministries</b> (Ephesians 4:11): anointed apostles, caring pastors, fiery evangelists, pure prophets and wise teachers; that each member may find his place in the body (Eph. 4:16), as a blessing for themselves and others..	15. for a greater <b>openness</b> in our society for the gospel, spiritual hunger (Amos 8:11): breaking down barriers and prejudices and taboos, a new mentality, a new spring, a thawing of frozen hearts, removing veils (Is. 25:7); for fertile ground, soft hearts.	16. for <b>governments</b> ., federal and regional governments and parliaments, local councils (mayor and councillors); against the influence of hidden groups like freemasons; that mammon will not rule our nation; for wise advisors (“Daniel’s”) on high places.	17. for <b>politics</b> : that God’s hand will put the right people in the right places (Dan. 2:21), and remove the wrong ones; for god fearing leaders; for honesty and transparency in the political debates; pray for Christian politicians that you know.	18. for <b>other authorities</b> and leaders: in the judiciary, police, army, the art world, economic world, science, and the world of education; against the spirit of the time ‘humanism’ and the mammon that rule modern thinking.
19. for the <b>royal family</b> : King Philip and Queen Mathilde, king Albert and Paola, Prince Laurent and Claire, Princess Astrid and Lorenz (1 Tim. 2:1-4): for strong role models, a uniting power and moral authority.	20. for <b>Brussels</b> , our capitol, seat for mighty organisations and very strategic city; for <b>Flanders and Wallonia</b> , that God will bless them abundantly in every area; for a good understanding between both parts.	21. for the <b>European Union</b> : that God’s hand will keep it, guide and use it as an instrument in His plan; that it will help European Christians to become one; pray for the Christians who work in the EU-institutions.	22. for the <b>schools and the education system</b> : for the schools of our children, for Christian teachers, Christian schools, religion teachers, and Christian student organizations; that in the <b>world of science</b> God may be respected.	23. for the <b>media</b> (TV, radio, papers, magazines, internet...): new respect for God: for open doors for the gospel. That God will be honored in the <b>world of arts</b> , with beautiful art; pray for Christians artists	24. for the <b>social testimony</b> of churches: that Christians may take the lead in charity, working with the weakest in our society (Matt. 25:45); pray for Christian aid organisations.	25. for <b>migrants</b> , political refugees, foreigners; for hospitality and tolerance by our people (Deut. 10:19, Matt. 25:35); for a fair migration policy and sound integration; that we will be open enough to also learn from them
26. That the difference between <b>light and darkness</b> will become more and more visible (alternative religions, the occult etc.) (Revelation 22:11); against misleading pseudo-religions, neopaganism, occultism etc.	27. for the <b>morality</b> of our land: for norms and values; that a dam may be raised to stop the overflow of immorality; that there will be an awakening of ethics; for reinstatement of marriage (against the gender-movement); for prophetic voices (Ef. 5: 11-13).	28. for the hundreds of thousands of <b>Muslims</b> in our country: pray for bold evangelists among them, for dreams and visions of Jesus, that many of them will find Jesus and for the formation of church communities for them.	29. for the <b>other churches</b> in your town: that they may be equally or more blessed; for the Roman Catholic church: for a rediscovery of the renewing power of the Word and strong preaching	30. for the current <b>young generation</b> (children and teenagers): that they may receive a strong Christian foundation so that when they grow up they will be able to carry their spiritual responsibilities and to reach their generation; pray for Christian youth movements	31. for <b>revival</b> , a spiritual awakening: That God’s powerful wind may blow through our land (Ezek 37:9-10), and that God will awaken his Church, cleanse her, sanctify, nourish, strengthen, cherish and heal her (Ef. 5:26-27)
